France is home to some of the world's most renowned museums and art galleries, and there are always new exhibitions to see. Here are some of the best art exhibitions in France this year.

The Musée d'Orsay in Paris is hosting an exhibition on the work of French painter Gustave Courbet. The exhibition includes over 100 paintings, drawings and photographs, and runs until January 20th.

The Centre Pompidou in Paris is also hosting a major exhibition this year, 'Picasso 1932: Love, Fame, Tragedy'. The exhibition looks at Picasso's work during the year 1932, when he produced some of his most famous paintings. It runs from February 28th to May 21st.

The Musée du Louvre in Paris is hosting an exhibition on the life and work of Leonardo da Vinci to mark the 500th anniversary of his death. The exhibition includes over 160 works by Leonardo da Vinci, including paintings, drawings, manuscripts and models. It runs from October 24th 2019 to February 24th 2020.

The Musée des Beaux-Arts de Lyon is hosting an exhibition on the work of French artist Henri Matisse. The exhibition includes over 100 works by Matisse, including paintings, sculptures, drawings and prints. It runs from October 9th 2019 to January 12th 2020.
